Camp Rules, Code of Conduct & Behavior Policy

1. Each youth participant will be expected to be on time *and* dressed in sports attire (sweats, shorts, athletic shoes, etc.) For safety reasons, we will not allow any youth to participate that is not in proper attire.
2. Each youth participant will be expected to show respect to the coaches and to each other.
3. Profanity, teasing, or bullying will not be tolerated.
4. No youth participant will be able to leave camp early without a parent/guardian.
5. Each youth participant will be expected to have fun and learn.
6. ALL Participants need to be pick up from camp by parent/guardian (please contact directors for other arrangements).
7. ALL Participants need to be picked up on time.

BEHAVIORAL POLICY:

**BBMJ Youth Health Sports Camp emphasizes a safe, fun, and healthy camp environment that fosters learning and friendship, and appropriate camp behavior is essential to a great overall experience for everyone involved. It is imperative that every camper feels included, safe, and part of our camp community.*

Behavioral Policy: BBMJ reserves the absolute right to dismiss a camper without refund for any behavior (1) that threatens or endangers the welfare and/or the safety of any camper, instructor, or any other person involved with the camp, (2) is disruptive to the overall camp environment, which interferes with the beneficial use and enjoyment by campers and staff, or (3) for any form of bullying of other campers or disrespectful behavior to camp authority.
